- Continue to work with Division 3 English Language Arts teachers on best practice in small group literacy instruction like Book Clubs
- Encourage all teachers to attend relevant professional development
- Continue to update reading resources
- Work with literacy consultants to increase the capacity of educational assistants
- Division 3 teachers will learn about how structure can improve small group instruction

The percentage of students who achieved the acceptable standard and standard of excellence in: Grade 6 Language Arts PAT.

The percentage of students who achieve the acceptable standard and standard of excellence in: Grade 9 Language Arts PAT.

The percentage of families who agree the literacy skills their child's learning at school are useful.

The percentage of EIPS stakeholders who agree children are becoming ready to enter Grade 1 as a result of being in the kindergarten program.

### ***OTHER MEASURES:***

By the end of the school year, number of students in K-3 who move out of the "At-Risk" measure using the GOA literacy assessments.
